Awards- Individual race medals will be determined based on the number of entries.

Team awards will be given out to 1st place teams in Varsity and Frosh/Soph levels only, no JV team awards.

Timing/Results- Chip timing provided by [Finished Results](#) with live results available on their app

Declaration/Registration - We are asking that all teams **declare their intention to compete by October 1st** on FinishedResults.com. Once teams have declared, entries can be made on FinishedResults.com and must be completed by **Oct. 14th**.

To enter athletes: Go to FinishedResults.com, click on "Schedule" at the top of the site and then find the "Riverside Invitational." [Direct link to meet page](#) Click on Entries and login to begin the team entry procedures. If you have already entered your team this season on Finished Results this will be an easy process. Don't worry about placing your athletes in specific races within the division, with the chip timing you can just send the athletes to the line for their race. It may appear that all runners are "varsity" but the result system will have them in the correct races.

Admission/Parking - No Admission will be charged. Spectator cars will be charged \$10. Buses will drop off students in a different lot than the parking lot and then be directed to off-site parking. Please inform your bus drivers to follow the directions that will be sent out in the final meet information packet. **Teams coming in vans must have identifying markings or will be charged the \$10 parking fee.**

A snack bar will be available.

CHECK-IN Coaches will check-in upon arrival at the Athletes/Coaches entrance next to the clubhouse to pick up their meet packet which will include the timing chips. **It is up to the team coaches to distribute the correct chips to the correct athletes** based on the roster included in the team packet. The coach is also responsible for collecting the chips and returning them at the conclusion of the meet. A fee will be charged for any chips unreturned by the end of the meet.

Trainer Trainers will be on-site. Please provide your own tape and other supplies

Team Camp Area There is a designated team camp area that all teams must set up in. There is also a designated warmup area located adjacent to the team camp area.

Portable toilets will be available. Use of the bathrooms at the clubhouse will not be available for athletes or coaches.
